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2012 Annual Calls for Experience Summary of Changes

Policy and Calendar-Accident Year Calls

Starting with the 2008 reporting season, the Policy Year and Calendar-Accident Year Calls will be increased by one year every year for the next ten years, ultimately reaching 31 policy years and 30 calendar-accident years of experience. Loss Cost Multiplier Screen

Starting with the 2011 reporting season, carriers/groups are required to provide their filed loss cost multipliers (LCM) in addition to the percentage of business written for all carriers whose data is included in the Calls. Last year you were required to enter all filings that were in effect in 2009. We have expanded the LCM screen to include the 2010 data. Therefore, **please enter ALL filings that were in effect in 2010 on the 2010 screen**. This information will be used to validate DSR premium. We will be editing traditional and large deductible policy years 2009 and 2010 data ONLY. Entry of the LCM data is **required to validate** the Calls.

Large Loss and Catastrophe Call

Circular Letter No. 10-1584 announced the addition of a Large Loss and Catastrophe Call as requested by the Workers' Compensation Reinsurance Association (WCRA) starting with calls reported in 2012. This Call collects claim-level detail on large loss claims where the total case incurred losses (the sum of indemnity paid and indemnity case reserves plus medical paid and medical case reserves) are **\$500,000 or greater**. This Call is also used to capture claim-level detail for specific extraordinary catastrophic events, regardless of the size of the claim. There are currently no catastrophic events for which we would capture Minnesota claim experience. This additional Call form can be found by selecting the Large Loss Call from the call selection drop down box.

Error Explanations

Two enhancements have been made to the Error Explanations section of ACCEDE. The first change is in regards to validation. **Validation will no longer remove any previously entered explanations**. The second change **requires the entry of an explanation for EVERY error and/or warning prior to submission**. Call submission checkboxes will be disabled until all explanations have been entered.

Supplemental Call for Schedule Rating Adjustments

New Schedule Rating edits have been added to ACCEDE that will also require an explanation prior to submission.
