**Enhancements To EXR
Experience Rating Worksheet Lookup
Effective August 6, 2007**

This announcement is intended for customers using EXR, the Experience Rating Worksheet Lookup product. Enhancements have been made to EXR that will allow the user to use this product more effectively. These enhancements include:

- A print feature which will create a PDF file of selected ratings, which can be printed or saved.
- The File Number, Rating Type, and Modification Factor have been added to the search results screen.
- The search results screen can now be downloaded in an Excel format.
- Merit Rating information will be added for participating DCOs.
- Rating Type has been added to the search criteria.
- Results Page Size has been added to the search criteria, which allows the user to choose the number of ratings that will be returned on one page. All ratings selected for the Print PDF feature must be included on the same page to be included in the same file.
