The need for two "IDs" emanates from MWCIA's responsibility to collect, identify, and process policy data

All of an employer's Workers' Compensation policies and policy transactions, including renewal policies, zeroes, but it must be seven digits.

2-Combinable (Combo) Group ID: This is the unique 9-digit number MWCIA assigns to the Coverage

In the case of experience rating, the rules of experience rating state that MN employers (more than one) who share a common majority (more than 50%) ownership are combinable for experience rating purposes.
